## ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

### Brush

- Christmas Trees (no decorations)
  - (December 26, 2022 - January 31, 2023)
- Pine Cones
- Pine Needles
- Wood Chips
- Wood/Tree Limbs (up to 12 inches in diameter and 8 feet long)

### Leaves

- Leaves
- Shredded Leaves

### Grass

- Flower/Garden Plants (Free of dirt)
- Grass Clippings (Green dry and odor free)
  - (April 19, 2022 - October 1, 2022)
- Yard Vegetation (Free of dirt)

## UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

### Wood

- 2 x 4s, etc.
- Bamboo
- Construction Materials
- Hay
- Logs or Branches (Over 12" in diameter)
- Mulch (Old or used)
- Plywood
- Pressure Treated Wood
- Railroad Ties
- Sod
- Straw
- Stumps
- Telephone Poles
- Treated Fence Post or Fence
- Walnuts and Other Tyles of Nuts

### Grass

- Decomposed Grass (Foul odor)
- Hay
- Manure
- Ornamental Grass
- Cattails, Rushes, Sedges or Restios
- Straw

### Other

- Bags of any type (including compostable)
- Fruit or Vegetables (Loose or attached to plant)
- Household Waste
- Inorganic Material (Rocks, stone, brick, cinder block concrete)
- Metal (Of any type)
- Soil
